Objects of the Alberta Home Education Association

The purpose of AHEA is:

- 1. To promote and encourage home education as a valid alternative to other public, separate and private school models.
- 2. To advocate for parental authority and religious freedom in education, for the interests of home educators, and to encourage Member engagement in home education advocacy.
- 3. To promote high-quality home education programs, which address the spiritual, intellectual, emotional, and physical needs of children and contribute to their development of Christ-like character.
- 4. To liaise with other educational institutions and the government in order to coordinate and facilitate the transition of individuals educated through home education programs into schools, colleges, universities, and other post-secondary educational institutions.
- 5. To engage in and/or promote research and study in the area of home education, as we are able, including but not limited to:
 - 5.1 Home education curricula;
 - 5.2 Teaching techniques; and
 - 5.3 Programs, activities, and facilities available to home educators.
- 6. To provide information and ideas with respect to home education.
- 7. To provide support, encouragement, advice, and networking opportunities for Members involved in home education.
